

3 of a family die as their car plunges into SRSP canal

EVEN before people forgot the incident of car falling in a canal in Warangal district, same kind of mishap took place on Monday morning in Medipally mandal of Jagtial district.

Three members of a family were killed after the car they were travelling plunged into SRSP canal and one escaped narrowly. The deceased were identified as Katkuri Amarendar Rao, his wife Sirisha and daughter Shreya. Rao's son Jayanth managed to escape from the water.

Amarendar Rao, an advocate of Jagtial town, along with his family was going to his native place Joginipally village to attend temple festival. When the car reached Medipally, Jayanth, who was driving the car, lost control of the wheel and plunged into the canal. Jayanth

escaped from car by opening the door but the remaining three got stuck in the car and died. Police rushed to the spot and removed the car from the canal with the help of crane and sent the bodies to Jagtial Govern-

ment Hospital for postmortem. It's learnt that Amarendar was a close relative of MLA Sanjay Kumar. It's also learnt that his daughter Shreya's engagement was conducted recently.

Construction site where centring collapsed in Mahabubabad on Monday

6 hurt in centring collapse

WORKERS at a construction site had a narrow escape when the centring for the construction of the building entrance of the new Integrated Collectorate Complex collapsed in Mahabubabad on Monday. However, the mishap left six workers, who were fixing the centring, with injuries. District Collector VP Gautham inspected the construction site and elicited information about the incident from the Roads & Buildings (R&B) Department.

Speaking to reporters, Gautham said that six workers sustained minor injuries and they are being treated at the Government Area Hospital. According to preliminary information, centring collapsed as iron rods bent. The Collector directed the R&B officials to submit a detailed report on the incident. Municipal Chairman P Rammohan Reddy also visited the construction site. Mahabubabad Town Inspector J Venkataratnam said that they have not received any complaint from the district administration about the mishap.

Suspecting fidelity, man kills wife

A man stabbed his wife to death at Namalpadu forest area under Bayyaram mandal in Mahabubabad district on Monday. The victim has been identified as Saritha (25) of Penugonda village under Kesamudram mandal.

According to police, accused A Naresh, a driver working in Mahabubabad, got married to Saritha some four years ago and used to beat his wife suspecting her fidelity. As a result, Saritha along with her children has been staying with her parents at Jayyaram village of Chinnagudur for some time.

Against this backdrop, Naresh came to Saritha parents' home on Monday morning and took his wife along with him on the premise of taking her to hospital for her treatment. After taking her to Namalpadu forest area, he stabbed her to death, the police said.

Bayyaram Inspector K Thirupathi said that they have taken Naresh into custody. The police shifted the victim's body to Government Area Hospital in Mahabubabad for postmortem.

Massive plantation drive to be launched tomorrow

DISTRICT Collector C Narayana Reddy has directed the authorities to make all arrangements for the mass tree plantation drive, where 5.30 lakh saplings will be planted on February 17. He told them to complete arrangements one day advance.

Addressing the officials at a meeting at Nizamabad Collectorate on Monday evening, the Collector asked them to plant minimum 1,000 plants in each village. MPDOs were told to take the responsibility of informing MPs, MLCs and all village representatives to make them partners in the massive plantation drive and to send invitations. He directed MPDOs and district officers to visit villages on February 16 and check whether all arrangements were completed or not.
