## Actor Soubin Shahir arrested in financial fraud case; released on bail

In a significant development, actor and producer Soubin Shahir was arrested by Maradu Police in Kochi in connection with the high-profile Manjummel Boys financial fraud case. Co-producers Babu Shahir and Shaun Antony were also taken into custody after two days of intensive questioning. However, as the Kerala High Court had previously granted anticipatory bail, all three were released shortly after their arrest.

The case was filed by Siraj Valiyathura, a resident of Aroor, who alleged that the producers collected a total of ₹7 crore from him over multiple phases, promising a 40% share in profits. However, no such profits were shared, leading to charges of breach of trust and financial fraud.

Speaking to the media after his release, Soubin clarified that the entire investment had already been returned and the profit share amount was kept ready for disbursement, claiming the complaint came just as the payment was

about to be made.

Police reports revealed that investors were allegedly misled into believing that the film's first schedule had been completed, even before production began. The accused had approached the High Court seeking to quash the FIR, but their plea was rejected, allowing the investigation to proceed. The producers countered, saying that delays in investment from Siraj disrupted the production schedule, resulting in financial setbacks and postponed returns.

Manjummel Boys, directed by Chidambaram, emerged as a record-breaking Malayalam blockbuster, collecting over ₹240 crore worldwide, with notable success in Tamil Nadu and a decent performance in Telugu states despite a delayed release.

Amidst legal scrutiny, Soubin continues to expand his career, now playing a key role in Lokesh Kanagaraj's 'Coolie', starring Rajinikanth, slated for release on August 14.

# Seven spoons of joy: A burmese-inspired dessert journey

A thoughtfully reimagined dessert experience where tradition meets texture, flavour meets creativity, and every spoonful tells a story

Slow down and surrender to the subtle pleasures of dessert—that's the essence of The Sweet Life, a new plated dessert menu at Burma Burma, Hitech City. Inspired by Burmese ingredients and culinary memories, the menu brings together seven carefully crafted desserts that play on nostalgia, texture, and modern technique.

Each dish blends familiarity with flair. The Milk Tea Cheesecake, infused with Burmese laphet ye (milk tea), pairs beautifully with a warm apple compote and a hint of cinnamon. Banana and Cashew Tres Leches transforms the classic into a richer, nuttier version layered with banana confit, cashew streusel, chocolate chantilly, and banana caramel ice cream.

There's also Berry Burst, where coconut custard meets pineapple compote, topped with cinnamon gelato and a honeycomb-semolina crumble—creamy, tangy, and unexpectedly refreshing.

For those drawn to indulgence, the Silkroute Sundae is a standout. Saffron-pistachio gelato and apricot-saffron confit are hidden inside a shimmering gold chocolate shell—a nod to

Burma's ancient trade routes and festive opulence. The Celebration Cake is pure theatre: a seven-layer chocolate dessert served with a tart cherry sorbet and finished with a warm chocolate pour, tableside. On the fruitier end of the spectrum, the Flower Bouquet features tropical fruit salsa, crisp meringue, and coconut-ginger ice cream, while the Coconut and Pineapple Crème Brûlée offers a tropical take on the French classic with custard, pineapple compote, cinnamon gelato, and semolina cake crumble.

"Our new menu reimagines familiar desserts with Burmese influence," says Head Chef Ansab Khan. "Each one is inspired by stories of fruit stalls, markets, and the seasonal abundance we grew up with." In Burmese culture, fruits symbolise prosperity and celebration, often exchanged during festivals or shared among families and friends. Co-founder Ankit Gupta echoes the sentiment: "This menu was created with the belief that dessert can do more than satisfy a craving. It can comfort, surprise, and even transport. The Sweet Life is our way of inviting guests to pause and savour something joyful."



## Try this cheese, greens & golden crunch taquitos



Crispy on the outside, melty on the inside—these Corn, Spinach & Cheese Taquitos are a flavour-packed snack, perfect for sharing. Serve hot with sweet chili sauce and enjoy every bite!

### Ingredients

- Fresh Golden Corn – 150g (boiled or grilled, kernels removed)
- Fresh Spinach – 100g (blanched and chopped)
- Mix Cheese (cheddar/mozzarella or any combo) – 100g
- Garlic – 10g (finely chopped)
- Onion – 50g (finely chopped)
- Jalapeños – 30g (optional, chopped)
- Salt & Pepper – to taste
- Spring Roll Sheets – as required (about 10)
- Sweet Chili Sauce – to serve

### Method

- Heat a little oil in a pan. Add chopped garlic and sauté until aromatic.
- Add chopped onions and cook until soft and translucent.
- Add the corn and cook for 2–3 minutes.
- Add chopped spinach, season with salt and pepper, and cook off any excess moisture.
- Turn off the heat and let the mixture cool slightly.
- Stir in the mixed cheese and chopped jalapeños (if using) to form a sticky, cheesy filling.
- Place a spring roll sheet on a clean surface in a diamond shape (corner facing you).
- Spoon 1–2 tablespoons of the filling near the bottom corner.
- Roll tightly, folding in the sides as you go to form a cigar-shaped taquito.
- Seal the edge with a little water or flour paste.
- Repeat with the remaining sheets and filling.
- Deep fry or air-fry the taquitos at 180°C until golden brown and crisp.
- Drain on a paper towel.
- Serve hot with sweet chili sauce on the side for dipping.
- Garnish with chopped jalapeños or a sprinkle of cheese if desired.
