Tourism Minister calls upon brides and grooms to hold their wedding ceremonies at unique tourist destinations in state

STATING that the government was working towards making Telangana a leading destination in the world for weddings, the Tourism Minister Jupally Krishna Rao on Sunday urged the wedding planners to aim to make Telangana a leading wedding destination.

The Minister Jupally Krishna Rao was speaking at South India Wedding Planners Congress organised under the Telangana Chamber of Events Industry (TCEI) in association with the Tourism Department at the Akshaya Convention in the Financial District.

The Minister said that the wedding industry in India was growing rapidly and Telangana was ready to play a key role in it. He said that the entire world was looking at India as a wedding destination and at such a time, the aim is to establish Telangana as a hub for wedding celebrations



on the world map. He said that Telangana is a wonderful venue for holding weddings according to various themes and budgets, with ancient forts, palaces, dense forests, rivers, lakes, hills, modern luxury hotels. "There are many wonderful places in Telangana that can transform this wealth into a world-class wedding destination," he said, calling upon wedding planners to see Telangana not just as a state, but as a living culture with a new perspective, and introduce it not only in In-

dia but also internationally.

The Minister called upon the brides and grooms to complete their wedding ceremonies at the unique tourist destinations in Telangana and preserve sweet memories. He said that plans would be made to promote the details of destinations across Telangana and explain why weddings should be held in Telangana. Special FAM (Familiarization) tours will be organized to directly introduce the wonderful wedding destinations of the state to the industry,



licenses, permits, logistics, and necessary permissions for organizing weddings will be granted quickly, new policies are being prepared to encourage investments in this sector with private-public partnership, and the Tourism Department was moving forward with the slogan "You think, we will implement".

The Minister said, "You have proven yourself to be the best wedding event in South India, now it is time to become the number one wedding event in the coun-

try, and for the next edition, the name of "South Indian Wedding Planners Congress" will be changed to "Indian Wedding Planners Congress" and various cultures of India like Rajasthan, Punjab, Kashmir, Goa will be introduced on one platform," said Krishna Rao referring to the organizers to do so.

Tourism Department Special CS Jayesh Ranjan, TCEI President Alla Balar-am Babu, General Secretary Ravi Bura, and others participated in this program.

Poshan Mahotsav from Sept 17 to promote nutritious eating habits

Women and Child Welfare Minister Seethakka says special campaign programmes would be organised to reduce consumption of junk food

THE state government would be celebrating 'Poshan Mahotsav' for one month from September 17 to October 16. Anganwadis will be visiting every house and provide 'Poshan Sandesh'.

Women and Child Welfare Minister Dhanasari Anasuya (Seethakka) said that the Poshan Masam Mahotsav was being organised with the support of the central government with the aim of improving the health and nutrition of children and women. Plans have been prepared to reach every household with the message of nutrition through Anganwadi staff to encourage them to eat healthy food, said Seethakka, who wrote letters to the public representatives of the state.

The Minister asked the public representatives to actively participate in the successful organization of the Poshan Masam festival and to encourage these programs in their constituencies.

She said that since nutrition is the first step for family health, the main purpose of this month was to create awareness on nutrition in every household.

The Minister revealed that the state government had released funds of Rs 30,000 for each ICDS project and Rs 50,000 for each district to

undertake special programs to create awareness among the people. Instructions were issued to the concerned officials to organize awareness programs, camps and health check-up camps on nutrition from the village level to the district and state levels using these funds.

The Minister said that many steps were being taken to provide quality pre-primary education to children and the necessary nutrition to the body on the occasion of this Poshan Masam. She said that special campaign programs would be organized to reduce the consumption of junk food and to raise awareness among the people on the use of sugar, salt and oil. She said that in order to promote proper eating habits among the people, the message of nutrition will be taken to every household with the help of Anganwadi workers.

The Minister explained that the purpose of this program was to create comprehensive awareness about

nutrition in families by increasing the participation of men in the Nutrition Mission. She said that programs to promote the consumption of products at the rural level and increase self-reliance will also be organized as part of this with the slogan "Vocal for Local". She revealed that nutrition data would be collected at the village level with the use of technology and regular monitoring will be carried out on them. She said that steps were already taken to organize mega health camps across the state under the Health and Family Welfare Department during the Poshan Masam. The Minister said, "Building a Nutritional Telangana is the responsibility of all of us. This awareness should be raised in every village and every family. With the cooperation of public representatives, we will make this festival a success and pave the way for a healthy Telangana."

Details of the programs to be undertaken every day as part of the Poshan Month were prepared and sent to the districts. Accordingly, the respective programs will be undertaken simultaneously across the state. She appealed to all the people to play an active role in these programs. Minister Seethakka expressed the hope that this Poshan Masam would play a key role in building a nourished and healthy society.

11 lakh cases resolved in National Lok Adalat

₹595 crore compensation paid

A National Lok Adalat was held on Saturday across Telangana where 11.08 lakh cases were resolved. This included 3.63 lakh pre-litigation cases and 7.43 lakh cases that were pending in the courts.

According to Telangana State Legal Services Authority Member Secretary CH Panchashari, the settlement of these cases led to orders for compensation payments amounting to Rs. 595 crore. A notable case highlighted in the report was a road accident where the tribunal announced a compensation of Rs. 98.30 lakh, which was then settled for Rs. 1.20 crore with 8% interest by New India Assurance Company.

The beneficiary was Pawan Kumar, a B.Tech

student, who received this assistance nine years after the accident.

Benefits of Lok Adalats:

- No court fees: This makes the legal process accessible to all. If a case is already pending in a regular court and is settled at a Lok Adalat, the court fees paid are refunded.
- Fast and flexible: The process is informal and not bound by strict procedural laws like the Civil Procedure Code and the Indian Evidence Act, leading to quick resolutions.
- Binding awards: The decision is final and cannot be challenged in a higher court, which prevents further delays and litigation.
- Reduces burden on courts: By resolving a large number of pending and pre-litigation cases, Lok Adalats help reduce the workload on the conventional judicial system.
