The programme was launched with the idea of increasing competitiveness among students not only in studies and sports but also in handwriting. She herself participated in this programme and emphasised the importance of handwriting.

Experts say that writing a few pages by hand every day has many benefits, including preventing lifestyle idiosyncrasies, such as forgetfulness that come with age. Handwriting increases attention, discipline, and patience in students. It contributes to clarity, meaningful individualisation, improves academic standards, and

instils self-confidence and personality development in students.

In view of the above benefits the Collector had organised handwriting competitions for government school students in collaboration

with Paramita Educational Institution in Karimnagar recently.

As part of this, school level handwriting competitions were organised for government school students on August 20. From this, three

students were selected from each school and competitions were organised at the Mandal level.

Three students were selected from each Mandal level competitors. In this way, a total of 584 students

from 16 mandals of the district participated in the Mandal level competitions and 48 were selected for the district level final examination.

On September 7, the district level written examination competitions were held for these students at Paramita Heritage School in Padma Nagar. The awards will be presented to the winners at the Karimnagar Collectorate on September 15.

At the district level, two students in two categories will be selected for the first prize worth Rs 5,000 each. Similarly, Rs 4,000 will be awarded to the second prize winners; two students will be awarded Rs 3,000 each for the third prize; Rs 2,000 will be awarded to the fourth prize winners; and Rs 1,000 each to the fifth place winners.

Notably, along with the students, teachers, officers and employees also at-

tended the district level competition. Satpathy, Additional Collector Ashwini Tanaji Wakade, Municipal Commissioner Praful Desai along with district officials were also in attendance.

Speaking to The Hans India, Gangadhara MEO Enugu Prabhakar told that participating in the district level English handwriting competition was a great experience for him. "Beautiful handwriting is not just about the beauty of the letters, but also reflects the clarity of our thoughts," he said.

Prabhakar said that the competition taught him the importance of hard work, patience, and discipline.

Mittapalli Ritwika of ZPHS Gharshakurti added that due to the use of digital devices, most have almost forgotten how to write. Ritwika, who won the first rank at the Mandal level in the handwriting competition, said, "I am very proud to have participated in the competition along with Madam (Collector)."

GSR lays foundation stones for road devpt
