### Workshop on 'Zoning Regulations- Energy Efficiency Study' held

MUNICIPAL Corporation Commissioner Narapureddy Mourya announced that a workshop and awareness programme on 'Zoning Regulations and Energy Efficiency Study' will be held on October 28 at Kachhapi Auditorium,

Speaking on the occasion, Commissioner said that the event is being organised under the AMRUT (Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation) scheme in association with the School of Planning and Architecture (SPA), Vijayawada. The SPA has completed a study titled "Energy Efficiency Considerations in Zoning Regulations -

A Study of Tirupati", supported by the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA).

The study focuses on how zoning rules in Tirupati affect electricity usage and suggests ways to reduce power consumption through urban planning changes.

The results of this project will guide future energy-efficient planning policies. The SPA team carried out surveys, data analysis, and computerbased studies to prepare the final recommendations. These findings will be shared during the workshop, she added.

SPA Vijayawada Additional Professor Janamejaya, deputy city planner Khan and assistant city planner Murthy were present.

## **Chittoor mango farmers receive** Rs 146.84 crore subsidy

#### 31929 eligible farmers get subsidy of Rs 4 per kilo through DBT: Collector Sumit Kumar

Chittoor

THE State government has credited Rs 146.84 crore in subsidy directly into the bank accounts of 31,929 mango farmers in Chittoor district, fulfilling its promise to support mango growers, District Collector Sumit Kumar announced on Tuesday.

Addressing the media, the Collector said the subsidy was disbursed under the Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) system for 3.67 lakh metric tonnes of mangoes produced during the season. District Horticulture Officer Madhusudan Reddy also attended the press meet.

"As per the State Government's decision to provide a subsidy of Rs 4 per kilogram to mango farmers, Rs 146.84 crore has been credited to the accounts of 31,929 eligi-

ble farmers. The highest disbursement was recorded in Bangarupalem mandal," the Collector said.

He added that, unlike Tamil Nadu and Karnataka, Andhra Pradesh is the only state providing both subsidies and minimum support prices for mango growers. "On behalf of the mango farmers, I express gratitude

to the State government for standing by them," he noted.

The Collector explained that eligibility was determined after thorough verification through e-Crop booking and field inspections. Farmers who have not yet received the amount but meet the eligibility criteria need not worry, he said.

"They can submit their

grievances to RSK (Rythu Seva Kendras), or to mandal and district-level horticulture officials by October 30. Their eligibility will be verified within 48 hours," he assured.

He also mentioned that 21 farmers are eligible for subsidies exceeding Rs 5 lakh each, and their cases are under review before final payment. Referring to the food processing units in Gudipala, Punganur, and Bangarupalem, the Collector said units that fail to offer government-declared prices to farmers will not receive any support from the Industries Department.

"Agro-based industries should not operate solely for commercial or political interests, but must also consider the welfare of the farming community," the Collector added.

## Dinakar defends public private partnership in medical education

CHAIRMAN of 20-point programme implementation committee, Lanka Dinakar criticised former Chief Minister Y S Jagan Mohan Reddy, saying that while the present coalition government is attracting global companies like Google to the State, during Jagan's rule, companies left the State.

Addressing the media in Tirupati on Tuesday, he questioned who would believe Jagan's alleged false propaganda about the coalition government's efforts to establish new medical colleges.

In support of Public Private Partnership (PPP), Dinakar compared various State health schemes, under Y S Rajasekhara Reddy, NTR Vaidya Seva during N Chandrababu Naidu's earlier term, YS Jagan Mo-

Now, 10 new PPP medical colleges are being developed in various districts, adding 1,500 undergraduate and 240 postgraduate seats.

Dinakar alleged that Jagan's government reduced the State's convener quota to 42.5 per cent while favouring private interests, whereas the present coalition restored transparency with a 50 percent state quota, 35 percent management, and 15 percent NRI allocation through open tenders. BJP leaders Samanchi Srinivas, Naresh, BD Balaji, Prashanthi and others were also present.
