TG Speaker to resume hearing of turncoat BRS MLAs from tomorrow

TELANGANA Legislative Assembly Speaker Gaddam Prasad Kumar will take up the hearing of the remaining BRS MLAs, who are facing defection charges from November 6.

The BRS MLAs facing the charges of defection to Congress including Bhadrachalam MLA Tellam Venkat Rao and Jagtial MLA M Sanjay Kumar will be called on November 6 while Bhanuswada MLA Pocharam Srinivas Reddy and Khairatabad MLA Danam Nagender will attend the hearing on November 13. The Speaker has been taking up hearing of the petitions filed by the BRS party against its ten MLAs who had joined the Congress party.

While hearing and cross-examination has been completed for four MLAs so far, hearing of other six MLAs is yet to be taken up. The four MLAs had appeared along with their advocates. There was cross exami-

nation from both sides before the Speaker. The Speaker's office sources said that out of the ten MLAs facing charges, only eight of them have responded to the notices and hearing of only four MLAs was completed. The MLAs, who appeared at the hearing along with their lawyers, had argued that they were still in BRS and that there was no defection. However, the petitioners, BRS leaders, submitted evidence, affidavits and videos related to them.

It may be mentioned here that the BRS leaders had first approached the Speaker against the ten MLAs seeking their disqualification. With lack of response on their petition, they approached the High Court. When the High Court did not give a positive verdict to BRS, the party approached the Supreme Court. The Apex court took up the hearing and directed the Speaker's office to take a decision within three months, which ends on October 31.



According to the sources in the Speaker's office, the MLAs will be attending the inquiry along with their advocates on November 6 and there will be cross-examination with arguments from both the sides. Similarly, two more MLAs will be called on November 13.

Kishan Reddy urges voters to reject Cong-BRS-Majlis 'alliance'

- Terms Pathangi party behind the Hastam party to deceive people
- Called to back Deepak Reddy in Jubilee Hills

UNION Minister G Kishan Reddy launched a fierce attack on the Congress, BRS and Majlis parties on Tuesday during a rally at Krishna Kant Park in support of the BJP's Jubilee Hills candidate Lankala Deepak Reddy. He called on voters to rewrite history in the upcoming November 11 by-election, declaring it a turning point for Hyderabad's future.

Reddy accused the BRS government of nurturing the Majlis party over the past decade, alleging that officials during both Congress and BRS regimes had to seek Majlis permission to enter Old City areas. He traced the Congress-Majlis alliance back to the days of Salahud-



din Owaisi, claiming the party had suppressed the Telangana movement and incited communal tensions. He criticised Congress for fielding a candidate in Jubilee Hills who previously contested under the Majlis banner in 2014, calling it a political compromise. "Behind the Hastam Party is the Patang Party," he said, alleging that Congress had struck a deal with Majlis for the Mayor's seat.

Reddy condemned the Congress government for destroying the Peddamam-

magudi in Banjara Hills and allocating graveyard lands in Mehdiptnam and Erragadda, accusing them of indulging in divisive politics. He warned that if the BJP doesn't win, Majlis' influence will continue unchecked.

He also slammed Congress's unfulfilled promises, including free scooters for students, Rs 2,500 monthly aid for women, and Rs 4,000 for unemployed youth. "These are not guarantees, they are 420 sub-guarantees," he said.

Calling for a boycott of the "three family parties" - Congress, BRS and Majlis--Reddy urged voters to remember the sacrifices of 1,200 martyrs, who fought against the Nizam's Razakars. He criticised the lack of development in Jubilee Hills under the BRS MLAs' 11-year tenure, citing poor roads and overflowing drains. Terming Deepak Reddy as a people's candidate, and urged voters to support the BJP for real development and unity in Telangana.
