

Ravi Narayan Reddy Award befitting for Justice Sudarshan Reddy: CM

CHIEF Minister A Revanth Reddy, on Monday said that it is fitting that the Ravi Narayan Reddy National Award has been bestowed upon Justice B Sudarshan Reddy.

He congratulated the organisers for taking the right decision at the right time. Chief Minister Revanth Reddy praised that while Burgula Ramakrishna Rao and Ravi Narayan Reddy inspired the first generation, people like Jaipal Reddy and Sudarshan Reddy have inspired the later generation of Telangana society.

He recalled that in 2019, he had requested Jaipal Reddy to remain

in politics, as he believed that committed and questioning individuals should be in politics. At that time, Jaipal Reddy told him that the generation had changed, that he was distancing himself from direct politics, and encouraged the younger generation to be in politics.

The Chief Minister said that Jaipal Reddy and Ravi Narayan Reddy were great leaders, who respected the changes in society and the thoughts of the people. He said that Justice Sudarshan Reddy's commitment frightens Modi, which is why Rahul Gandhi fielded him as a candidate for the Vice Presidency.

He recalled that Sudarshan Reddy contested the elections against the rule of a single party and a single individual, with the aim of instilling the spirit of democracy in the people. The Chief Minister stated that it is fitting to present the Ravi Narayan Reddy award to such a person.

Chief Minister Revanth Reddy said that Ravi Narayan Reddy was a great man, who played a key role in the armed peasant struggle against anarchic forces. He was praised as a great man who, despite being born into a feudal family, donated his 500 acres of land for the poor.

He fought against monarchical rule and for the liberation from forced labour. He was remembered as a great man who influenced even illiterate people like Bandi Yadagiri, who awakened Telangana society with his song "Bandenaka Bandi Katti, Padaharu Bandlu Katti" (a song about connecting cart after cart, sixteen carts in total).

He was elected as a Member of Parliament with a larger majority than even the country's first Prime Minister, Nehru. The Chief Minister stated that Nehru had Ravi Narayana Reddy inaugurate the first Parliament building to reflect the people's mandate. He described Ravi Narayana Reddy as a great leader who, at the age of sixty, inspired the people by stepping down from party and political positions. He remarked that in this era, some people are unwilling to relinquish their positions even after being defeated by the people.

The Chief Minister stated that after the municipal elections, steps would be taken to give Ravi Narayana Reddy the respect he deserves.

HYDERABAD has firmly established itself as a strategic railway hub in southern India, with the Union Budget 2026-27 placing the city at the centre of a high speed rail triangle connecting Pune, Chennai and Bengaluru. The sustained focus on railway infrastructure has resulted in unprecedented growth for Telangana, reflected in a sharp rise in budget allocation, network expansion and passenger amenities.

The average annual railway budget allocation for Telangana has increased nearly six times, from Rs 886 crore during 2009-14 to a record Rs 5,454 crore in 2026-27. This significant rise underscores the Central Government's commitment to strengthening rail connectivity and accelerating economic development in the state.

Railway infrastructure projects worth Rs 47,984 crore are currently

under execution in Telangana, covering new line construction, doubling works, station redevelopment and safety upgrades. These initiatives are designed to enhance operational capacity, improve efficiency and deliver a superior travel experience for passengers.

A key highlight of the budget is Hyderabad's inclusion in three high speed rail corridors, forming a southern triangle diamond project. These corridors will connect Hyderabad with Pune, Chennai and Bengaluru using trains capable of running at speeds of up to 350 kilometres per hour.

Once operational, travel time between Hyderabad and Bengaluru is expected to reduce to two hours, Hyderabad to Chennai to 2 hours 55 minutes, and Hyderabad to Pune to just 1 hour 55 minutes. The project is expected to act as a powerful economic growth corridor supporting education, healthcare, trade and industry. Station redevelopment is also

progressing rapidly under the Amrit Station Scheme. Forty stations in Telangana have been identified for comprehensive upgradation at a cost of Rs 2,015 crore, with redevelopment already completed at Begumpet, Karimnagar, Warangal and Sri Bala Brahmeswara Jogulamba.

Telangana has achieved 100 per cent electrification of its railway network, with around 900 kilometres of new tracks laid since 2014. To enhance safety, the indigenous KAVACH train collision avoidance system is being implemented across major routes, alongside the construction of 499 flyovers and underpasses.

Sanjay Kumar Srivastava, General Manager, South Central Railway, said the scale of investment marks a turning point for the state. "The record budget allocation and high speed rail connectivity will transform Hyderabad into a major mobility and logistics hub while ensuring safer, faster and more reliable rail services for the people of Telangana," he said.

Cyber crime awareness drive to shield citizens from digital fraud

IN a concerted effort to educate and safeguard citizens from the rising tide of digital fraud, the Hyderabad Cyber Crime police conducted a specialised awareness programme at a mosque in Golconda. The session took place at Masjid Ibad ur Rahman and was specifically tailored for teachers and students. Led by Golconda SHO Saidulu and his dedicated team, the initiative provided clear and practical guidance on identifying mobile related cyber crimes, fake OTP scams, fraudulent links, and various online traps used by criminals.

The officers explained the sophisticated methods cybercriminals employ to target vulnerable individuals and offered advice on responsible internet usage. They emphasised that no government agency, including the Police, CBI, ED, or

RBI, will ever conduct investigations, arrests, or account verifications via phone or video calls. Furthermore, authorities never demand the transfer of money for the clearance of cases or safekeeping.

Fraudsters often exploit fear by alleging Aadhaar misuse or money laundering, but the police urged the public not to panic.

The community was strictly advised never to share bank details or account credentials with unknown callers. Anyone who falls victim to a scam should immediately report the incident to the nearest station or call 1930.

The community thanked the officers for their valuable efforts in safeguarding society through this proactive initiative. This successful programme highlights the importance of using community spaces to spread vital safety information and ensure that all digital citizens remain well informed and protected.

Ganesh Utsav Samithi slams cases against 'Chalo Balapur' participants

HYDERABAD: The Bhagyana-ganesh Utsav Samithi has condemned the police registering cases against the participants who had participated in 'Jago Bhayaganar - Chalo Balapur' program held on January 24.

Wow! Two-time kidney transplant recipient scripts Antarctica history

IN a landmark achievement, Sneha Raju has become the world's first two-time kidney transplant recipient to set foot on Antarctica, camp overnight there, and cross the Antarctic Circle.

The historic expedition took place from December 17 to 28 and was conducted in full compliance with established Antarctic expedition standards. This is the first time that an individual has successfully accomplished the typical Antarctic expedition, including interior landing, overnight camping, and Circle crossing, after undergoing two kidney transplant surgeries.

This makes the triumph a first-of-its-kind in the world, eligible for global recognition.

The expedition began from Ushuaia on December 17, 2025, crossing the notoriously challenging Drake Passage before reaching the Antarctic Peninsula. On December 19, the first landing was made at Barrientos Island, followed by an official continental landing at Portal Point.
