CINEMATOGRAPHY minister Kandula Durgesh on Tuesday said that the coalition government is fully committed to the development of the Telugu film industry in Andhra Pradesh and would begin a structured action plan from April. He also announced that discussions are underway with Chief Minister N Chandrababu Naidu and Deputy Chief Minister Pawan Kalyan, and a formal announcement on the revival of the prestigious Nandi Awards and Nandi Theatre Festival would be made soon.

The minister was speaking after felicitating the winners of the Andhra Pradesh Short Film Festival-2026, organised under the banner of Maa-AP, at his chamber in the Secretariat's second block at Velagapudi. He presented mementos and cash awards to the awardees and congratulated young directors, technicians and artists who created socially conscious short films.

Durgesh appreciated the efforts of the festival organiser, Maa-AP founder and film director Dilip Raja, for successfully conducting the state-level festival on January 11 at Tenali

without charging any entry fee. He said such initiatives play a key role in nurturing grassroots talent and strengthening the film ecosystem in the State.

Addressing the gathering, the minister stated that the government aims to develop Amaravati into a major hub for the film industry on par with Hyderabad. He reiterated that the state government would extend all necessary support for the growth of cinema and creative industries in Andhra Pradesh.

As many as 203 short films were received from across the state for the festival, with nearly 2,000 actors participating. The first prize was won by 'Mahavriksham' directed by Chandrasekhar Sakunala from Visakhapatnam, while 'Simhadri Appanna' by Srinivasa Rao from Srikakulam secured second place and 'Abaddam vs Nijam' by Naveen Kumar from Pala-

kollu bagged the third prize. Cash awards of Rs 1 lakh were presented to the top three winners. Special awards were also presented to Sujitha (Best Actress-Manam), Sai Prakarsh (Best Character Actress-Abaddam vs Nijam), Pawan Sarma (Mannu-Minnu), child artist Harshathunnisa, young talent Rithvik Reddy (Astra), debut director Trivikram, villain Meesala Bhaskar, and Telugu script reviewers Manjuluri Lakshmapathi Master and Jagadish, among others.

Speaking on the occasion, director Dilip Raja said government encouragement would enable Andhra Pradesh youth to achieve remarkable success and noted that the Short Film Festival had infused new confidence and determination among aspiring filmmakers.

CPM demands immediate increase in RTC buses

Party's two-day state committee meet flags overcrowding, commuter hardships after Stree Shakti scheme implementation

THE CPM state committee, which met on February 2 and 3 at MB Vignana Kendram in Vijayawada, demanded an immediate increase in RTC buses in view of the sharp rise in passenger traffic following the implementation of the Stree Shakti free bus travel scheme for women.

The meeting was held under the chairmanship of party central committee member K Lokanatham and was attended by politburo members B Raghavulu and U Vasuki, along with state secretary V Srinivasa Rao. The committee unanimously adopted a resolution highlighting the severe inconvenience being faced by passengers due to overcrowding.

Party state secretary Srinivasa Rao released the resolution to the media here on Tuesday. He said that RTC occupancy has increased dramatically from 67 per cent to 98 per cent after the launch of the Stree Shakti

scheme. However, the government failed to deploy additional buses to meet the growing demand, he said. As a result, buses are running beyond capacity, skipping stops, and

frequently breaking down due to poor maintenance and ageing fleets, he commented.

Further, he said the two-day state committee meeting expressed its concern over harassment faced by women passengers and the difficulties encountered by students who are unable to reach schools and colleges on time.

The party also pointed out that RTC staff are under heavy pressure, with workload rising by over 30 per cent, leading to an increase in in-service deaths, he said. Despite the corporation seeking permission to recruit 11,000 staff, the government has not responded, he noted.

Meanwhile, he said his party urged the government to ensure RTC services in villages still lacking bus connectivity, strictly regulate private buses, allow digital Aadhaar verification for women passengers, and immediately strengthen the public transport system to safeguard the Stree Shakti scheme and commuter safety.

Five Eagle teams to curb drug menace in EG dist

EAST Godavari district Superintendent of Police D Narasimha Kishore on Tuesday said that five special Eagle (Elite Anti-Ganja Law Enforcement) teams have been constituted in the district to intensify surveillance against narcotics. Each Eagle team comprises one in-charge officer and three staff members. For the first time in the State, one Eagle team

has been allotted to each sub-division, making East Godavari the pioneer district in implementing the sub-division-wise model, the SP said.

Addressing a meeting held to brief the newly formed teams, Narasimha Kishore said the Eagle personnel would move in plain clothes, mingling with the general public, while maintaining constant watch on drug trafficking, sale, and consumption. The teams have been provided with

two-wheelers to ensure swift mobility and effective monitoring.

Cautioning the youth, the SP said that even a single case related to ganja or narcotics could have long-term consequences on one's life. He said that such cases could affect prospects of obtaining passports, visas, jobs and NOCs. The public was urged to share any information related to narcotics by contacting the local police station or by dialling 112 or 1972.
