As the train was heavily crowded, the Minister did not attempt to find a seat but instead traveled standing alongside his fellow passengers. During the journey, he engaged in conversation with his co-travelers and inquired about the amenities available during the Metro ride. Although the passengers were initially surprised to see the Minister amidst them, they spoke to him enthusiastically once he greeted them. While several passengers showed keen interest in taking selfies with him, the Minister patiently posed for photos with them.

On the occasion, Jupally Krishna Rao expressed the view that the Metro contributes significantly to helping people reach their destinations quickly and without facing traffic congestion.

CONGRESS leader Pawan Khera on Wednesday moved the Telangana High Court seeking anticipatory bail in a case filed against him by the Assam government on his allegations against Chief Minister Himanta Biswa Sarma's wife.

Khera, who showed his residential address in Hyderabad, requested the court to release him on bail in the event of his arrest. The petition was filed on April 7. It will be taken up

by the court on April 9.

Khera named the DCP of Guwahati Crime Branch Police Station and Telangana government as respondents to his petition. The case was registered in the Guwahati Crime Branch Police Station against Khera under several sections of the BNS, including 175 (false statement in connection with an election), 35 (Right of private defence of the body and of property) and 318 (cheating). The Congress leader on April 5 alleged that Sarma's wife, Riniki Bhuyan



Sarma, has multiple passports and foreign property, which were not declared in the chief minister's election affidavit.

An Assam Police team had earlier visited the Delhi residence of Khera for questioning in connection with the case. Khera's advo-

cate Ponnam Ashok Goud told PTI that anticipatory bail was sought as the FIR copy has not been uploaded on police website as per Supreme Court's orders, and that the former's Delhi house was searched with an intention to arrest. Sarma on Tuesday

slammed the Congress for "not verifying" the documents based on which it brought allegations against him and his family. The CM asserted that Khera had "run away" to Hyderabad, but the Assam Police will "hunt him down even from 'patal' (netherworld)".

BRS leaders on Wednesday alleged that the media conference addressed by Minister Ponguleti Srinivasa Reddy on Wednesday was merely an attempt to cover up his own misdeeds and that the Chief Minister A Revanth Reddy was shielding the illegal activities of the Revenue Minister.

Addressing a press conference here, BRS MLA KP Vivekananda said Ponguleti Srinivas Reddy was the individual who fled to Kerala overnight the moment their leader Harish Rao talked about Raghav Constructions and its mining activities during the Budget Sessions. He is currently evading the situation by claiming to be engaged in election campaigning in the state of Kerala and the Revenue Department has become completely mired in corruption, alleged KP Vivekananda. The BRS leader said that it was their leader,

Harish Rao, who issued a bold challenge, declaring, "If we are wrong, then hang us!" Unable to accept this challenge, Ponguleti fled to Kerala overnight by flight. "Having run away like a thief to Kerala, he has now returned and is spouting utter nonsense. CM Revanth Reddy claims that Raghav Construction does not belong to Ponguleti Srinivas Reddy. Yet, Ponguleti asserts that Raghav Construction belongs to his son. Revanth Reddy is shielding the illegal activities of Ponguleti Srinivas Reddy," said Vivekananda. The BRS leader demanded that Minister Ponguleti Srinivas Reddy must resign immediately for engaging in illegal mining.

BRS General Secretary RS Praveen Kumar said that the media conference did not sound like a statement from the Revenue Minister. Instead, it sounded exactly like a statement from the Chairman of Raghav Construction—Minister Ponguleti Srinivas Reddy. One is left wondering: is



it Raghava Construction or Megha Engineering that is actually steering the people of Telangana? Indeed, it is Raghava Construction—specifically the Megha Engineering firm—that is steering the people of Telangana, he said. Regarding the Vattinagulapally land dispute, Ponguleti Srinivas Reddy's son must answer: did he or did he not visit the residence of Pallavi Shah and Satish Shah? "You must also answer whether or not Habibullah Khan—the officer who registered the case—was subsequently transferred.

2,322 additional nursing appointments within two days: Raja Narasimha

MINISTER for Health Damodar Raja Narasimha announced that the process of filling additional 2,322 nursing positions will be completed within the next two days. The Minister attended the Safe

Motherhood Day celebrations held at the Midwifery Training Institute in Boyaguda, an event conducted under the Praja Palana Pragathi Pranaliika initiative. During his remarks, he emphasised that the State government is prioritising the recruitment of nursing professionals in hospitals. Over the past two years, the government has reinforced the healthcare system by addressing more than 10,000 va-

cancies, the majority of which were nursing roles, he said. "We are creating new nursing colleges to enhance opportunities for students. In order to support international career prospects, we are also facilitating English, German, and Japanese language training for nursing students." Minister Raja Narasimha noted. Additionally, the Minister highlighted that the government is en-



hancing midwifery services within the state to promote natural births. As part of this initiative, midwifery training has been provided to 370 nurses. "We will establish midwifery training institutes in government nursing colleges and will also work towards decreasing the number of Cesarean deliveries," he stated.

Upcoming party will infuse new political culture in State: Kavitha

ALLEGED TELANGANA HAS BEEN TURNED INTO AN 'ATM' FOR THE CONGRESS PARTY TO FUND ELECTIONS ACROSS INDIA

TELANGANA Jagruti president Kalvakuntla Kavitha on Wednesday declared that April 25 will be a defining moment in the state's history, signaling the introduction of 'fresh blood and a new political culture' to the soil of Telangana.

The Jagruti leader was speaking during the joining programme of Nadigadda Hakkula Porata Samithi president G Ranjith Kumar from Jogulamba Gadwal at the party office on Wednesday.

Addressing the gathering, Kavitha emphasized that the upcoming party would break away from traditional politics to adopt a people-centric approach based on three pillars - questioning, fighting for public issues, and resolving the problems.



She criticized both the ruling Congress and the opposition BRS for neglecting public issues, stating that 'Jagruti' has become the only voice the public trusts to represent their concerns.

Kavitha further added that the party will work closely with people at the grassroots level, undertake padyatras, and develop a comprehensive agenda with the help of

international experts, which will be unveiled on April 25.

Kavitha launched a scathing attack on Chief Minister Revanth Reddy, accusing him of the "ATM" Allegation: She alleged that Telangana has been turned into an "ATM" for the Congress party to fund elections across India. She mocked the Chief Minister's subsmissiveness, claiming he remains stand-

ing even during phone calls with Rahul Gandhi. She highlighted the government's failure to implement Rythu Bharosa and complete farm loan waivers, accusing the CM of spreading lies in other states like Kerala while Telangana farmers suffer. She alleged that the current government misled the people and is prioritizing political interests over public welfare.

Kavitha questioned the Chief Minister's 'mysterious silence' regarding Prime Minister Narendra Modi's decisions. She specifically pointed to the national project status granted to Upper Bhadra, warning that it would starve the combined Mahabubnagar district of vital Tungabhadra water. "Why is Revanth Reddy 'Gup-Chup' (silent) when it comes to questioning Modi?" she asked.
