

Leaders take stock of Wanaparthy development and welfare progs

ing aids were distributed to 16 children jointly by the District Welfare Department and District Medical & Health Department. Buses were also handed over to women's federations from Wanaparthy and Chinnambavi mandals under the Indira Mahila Shakti scheme. The Agriculture Department distributed green manure and cumin seeds to several farmers.

The chief guests later visited and inspected stalls and photo exhibitions set up in the Collectorate premises.

Regarding Indiramma housing, he advised beneficiaries to construct houses within the prescribed limits, warning that exceeding the limits could push them back

into debt. He instructed officials to monitor the implementation carefully.

MLA Thudi congratulated officials who are effectively implementing welfare schemes. He announced that the Young India Integrated School in Wanaparthy constituency is being built at a cost of Rs 200 crore.

A new Wanaparthy District Hospital is being constructed at a cost of Rs 203 crore, with works progressing rapidly. He also said a CT Scan facility worth Rs 2.5 crore had been established at the district hospital with CSR funds from Union Bank of India. LPG connections have also been sanctioned to implement the midday meal scheme in all schools.

TOURISM Minister Jupally Krishna Rao said the government's goal is to eliminate the middlemen system and stressed that there should be no negligence regarding public petitions under any circumstances.

As part of the district-level programme under the Praja Palana Pragathi Pranalika initiative on Friday, Jupally and Wanaparthy MLA Thudi Megha Reddy attended as chief guests.

The event began with the singing of the Telangana State song, followed by the reading of Chief Minister Revanth Reddy's speech. Details were then presented regarding the welfare schemes being implemented by the

people's government in the Wanaparthy constituency and the beneficiaries receiving assistance.

Speaking on the occasion, Jupally said that under the leadership of Chief Minister Revanth Reddy, the government is introducing several additional welfare schemes along with continuing existing ones. He said the government is prioritizing education and healthcare by allocating major funds to these sectors.

He instructed officials to work toward the speedy resolution of public petitions and applications and reiterated that the aim is to completely eradicate the middlemen system. He emphasized that

public petitions should never be neglected and directed officials to ensure quick disposal of applications, especially those related to the Bhubharati land matters submitted by farmers.

SI, in-laws accused of dowry harassment

A woman has accused her husband, in-laws, and sister-in-law of subjecting her to severe harassment for additional dowry and forcing her out of the house. Seeking justice, the woman approached the police station. However, she alleged that Penpahad SI Gopikrishna did not support her and instead reacted angrily toward her.

According to the victim, she was married to Bhanu Prakash, a resident of Kummurabanda Thanda in Chilkur mandal of Suryapet district.

She stated that serious disputes had been occurring in the family for the past four months. Her husband, along with

her in-laws and sister-in-law, allegedly demanded additional dowry, physically assaulted her, and forced her to leave the house.

She made serious allegations that the SI had an illicit relationship with her sister-in-law and therefore favoured the accused family members. According to her, the police officer registered the FIR only as a formality and failed to conduct a proper investigation.

The victim claimed that whenever she approached the SI for justice, he insulted and threatened her instead of helping. She demanded that higher authorities intervene, examine phone records to uncover the truth.

Rain in sight: Paddy procurement expedited

ADDITIONAL Collector (Revenue) T Vinod Kumar directed officials to further speed up the paddy procurement process and ensure that farmers do not face any inconvenience.

He conducted a surprise inspection of the paddy procurement centres at Davajipalli and Pangal mandals on Friday; reviewed the procurement process and examined paddy stocks at the centres.

As rain has been forecast, he instructed that the paddy arriving at procurement centres should be collected as quickly as possible.

He also directed officials to regularly update truck sheets related to procured

paddy in the online system so that payments could be credited promptly into farmers' bank accounts.

He instructed vehicle contractors to ensure the availability of lorries and transport vehicles for moving the procured paddy to rice mills and warned that there should be no delays in transportation.

Later, he visited Basaveshwara Rice Mill, Mahalakshmi Rice Mill, and other locations within Wanaparthy limits to review storage arrangements for the collected paddy.

He inspected unloading facilities and storage capacity at the mills and instructed mill owners to speed up unloading and milling operations.
