

# Mahesh rules out PCC leadership change

### Some people unable to digest coordination between me and CM Revanth Reddy



Names of TPCC working presidents sent to AICC, announcement soon: Mahesh Kumar Goud

REACTING on a malicious campaign launched by a TV channel targeting him, PCC president Mahesh Kumar Goud on Saturday ruled out change in leadership of the Telangana Congress unit.

He asserted that any such decision rests solely with the All India Congress Committee (AICC), while dismissing criticism and media speculation against him.

Speaking during an informal interaction with the media in Gandhi Bhavan on Saturday, Mahesh Goud said party workers and the AICC leadership were the

appropriate authorities to appreciate his performance as TPCC chief.

"The high command has the final authority on any changes in PCC leadership. I was appointed PCC chief because the party believed I was the right person for the responsibility," he said.

Claiming that the AICC leadership has confidence

in him, Mahesh Goud stated that Congress general secretary KC VenuGOPAL had congratulated him on several occasions for his work.

The TPCC chief alleged that some individuals were uncomfortable with the coordination between him and Chief Minister A Revanth Reddy.

"I will not be intimidated

simply because a particular TV channel expresses its opinion. One channel running a campaign against me does not make it the ultimate truth," he remarked, while reiterating his respect for press freedom.

On party affairs, the TPCC chief revealed that the names of proposed working presidents had already been sent to the AICC and that appointments would be announced soon.

He also clarified that the proposed Telangana Cabinet expansion would be handled directly by the Chief Minister and that he would have no role in the process.

Mahesh Goud also clarified that Gandhi Bhavan belonged to the party trust and dismissed reports and rumours targeting him, saying he would not waste time responding to "trivial matters."

On the proposed "Future

City" project, the TPCC chief defended the Congress government's vision, stating that the project would become a model for the entire country. He accused the Bharat Rashtra Samithi (BRS) of lacking foresight and failing to expand Hyderabad during its tenure.

"Development happens only when a city expands. Is Harish Rao suggesting that Hyderabad does not require further development," he asked, criticising senior BRS leader T Harish Rao for opposing the initiative.

Mahesh Goud further alleged that the Central government was adopting a "step-motherly attitude" towards Telangana.

At the same time, he said the Congress government was continuing welfare schemes introduced by the previous administration, drawing a comparison with Tamil Nadu Chief Minister MK Stalin.

# BRS leader brutally murdered in Suryapet

POLITICAL tensions flared in Yarkaram village of Suryapet here on Saturday after BRS leader and former sarpanch's husband Chintalapati Madhu was allegedly murdered by unidentified assailants.

According to locals, the attackers killed him, packed the body in a gunny bag, and dumped it near Yarkaram stage area before fleeing the spot. The incident came to light after locals noticed the suspicious bag and alerted the police. Officers rushed to the scene, took custody of the body, and shifted it to Suryapet General Hospital for postmortem examination.

The deceased's wife alleged

that her husband was murdered due to political rivalry and personal enmity. Following the incident, tension prevailed in the village, prompting authorities to deploy heavy police security to maintain law and order.

Sources said that Madhu was previously an accused in

two murder cases. However, police are continuing their investigation, and further details regarding the murder are yet to be officially confirmed. Meanwhile, former minister and MLA G Jagadish Reddy alleged that the Congress party is encouraging murder politics in the state. Speaking to the media after paying tributes to slain leader in Suryapet, he claimed that the murder was a result of the Congress government's failure and questioned the role of the police in the incident. Jagadish Reddy accused Congress leaders and police officials of harassing BRS workers and weakening earlier murder cases involving party leaders. He also criticised the sudden change of the public prosecutor in a previous case.

## Inter suppli exam rescheduled to May 29

THE Telangana Board of Intermediate Education (TGBIE) has announced a change in the schedule for the Intermediate Public Advanced Secondary Examinations (IPASE), May/June 2026 session. The adjustment follows the State government's declaration of May 28 (Thursday) as a public holiday on the occasion of Eid-ul-Azha (Bakrid).

A TGBIE statement said on Saturday, the Environmental Education examination, originally slated for May 28, will now be held on May 29 (Friday) from 10 am to 1 pm. The rest of the examination schedule remains unchanged.

The decision was made in accordance with G.O.Rt. No.718, issued by the General Administration (SpLE) Department on May 22, 2026, which modified an earlier order that had declared May 27 as the holiday. The Board stated that the rescheduling aims to avoid inconvenience to students and examination administrators.

All principals of government, aided, private, and residential junior colleges have been instructed to inform students immediately and ensure wide publicity of the revised date.

Students are advised to take note of the change and attend the examination accordingly.

## Reject deceitful politics of Cong, BRS: NRR

HYDERABAD: Telangana BJP president N Ramchander Rao called upon the people to reject the "deceitful politics" of the Congress and BRS parties, accusing both of betraying the public's trust—especially the State's farmers and youth.

Addressing the media, Rao asserted that the BJP, under the leadership of Prime Minister Narendra Modi, has set a national standard for good governance and corruption-free administration for over a decade. "Today, the educated, intellectuals, youth, and women are closely observing the BJP's track record and the transparent governance delivered by Prime Minister Modi," he emphasised. Rao highlighted that citizens across India, particularly the younger generation, are increasingly placing their hopes in the BJP.

Citing recent developments in Telangana, Rao accused the Congress government of following in the footsteps of its predecessor, the BRS, by allegedly prioritising vested interests over public welfare. He alleged that both parties have pushed the State deeper into debt through mega
