Mahadasyam, and Pragna Nayan played pivotal roles.

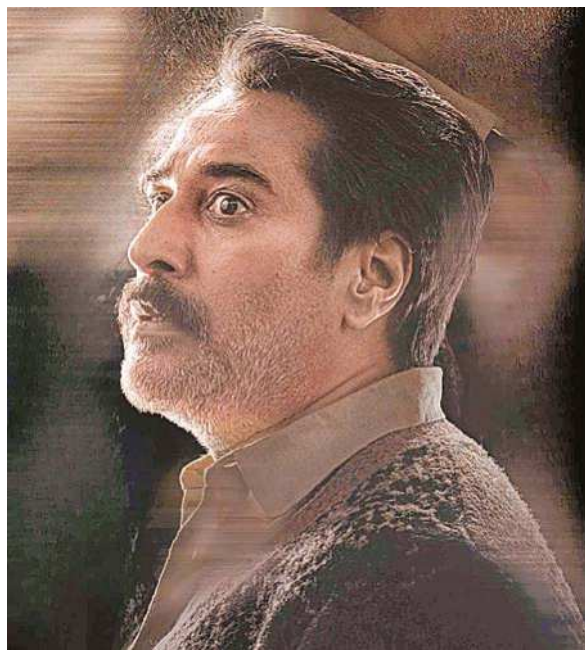
