

Ponguleti: Cong govt rooting for a thatched hut-free state

Minister directs officials to prioritise hut dwellers in second phase of Indiramma Housing Scheme

REVENUE, Housing and Information & Public Relations Minister Ponguleti Srinivas Reddy has said that the State Government is committed to ensuring that no poor family is forced to live in a thatched hut and that every household has access to a safe and dignified home.

Reviewing the implementation of the second phase of the Indiramma Housing Scheme through a teleconference with Housing Department officials on Wednesday, the Minister directed authorities to give the highest priority to families currently residing in huts while sanctioning new houses. Other applications, he said, should be considered only after all eligible hut dwellers are covered.

As part of the initiative, officials have been instructed to conduct an intensive field survey across villages, wards and municipalities to identify hut dwellers and verify existing government records.

The survey will also include verification of around 75,000 applications received during the Praja Palana programme from individuals claiming to live in huts.

Lists of eligible beneficiaries will be prepared at the MPDO level and submitted for approval.

The Minister stressed that the selection process must be transparent and free from discrimination based on caste, religion or political affiliation. Families living in huts, who did not apply earlier have also been given an opportunity to submit applications at their respective MPDO offices, which will be verified through field inspections.

The government has decided to construct 2.5 lakh houses in the second phase of the Indiramma Housing Scheme, with 2,000 houses allocated to each Assembly constituency.

Special emphasis is also being placed on the Roof Replacement Scheme. Under this programme, 50,000 houses statewide—500 in each constituency—will be selected for assistance. Families living in houses with structurally sound walls but unsafe roofs made of tarpaulin sheets, tin sheets or stone slabs will receive financial assistance of up to Rs 2 lakh to construct RCC roofs.

The Minister also directed officials to identify and support incomplete houses sanctioned under previous schemes, including Indiramma and Gruhalakshmi. He reiterated that the Beneficiary-Led Construction (BLC) model would continue, with permission for G+1 construction in urban areas where plot sizes are limited.

12 OU BDS students face action over alleged ragging

THE Sultan Bazar police have registered a case against 12 Bachelor of Dental Surgery students for allegedly ragging junior students at Osmania Medical College. The incident reportedly came to light after first-year students lodged formal complaints alleging harassment by senior students.

According to the police, a case was registered against 12 final-year BDS students under the Telangana Prohibition of Ragging Act following an official complaint lodged by college principal Sanjeev Singh Yadav. The students of Government Dental College are currently accommodated in the Osmania Medical College hostel, where the alleged incident took place.

Taking a serious view of the matter,

the college administration initiated immediate disciplinary action and suspended the 12 final-year BDS students for six months for subjecting their juniors to physical and mental harassment.

The principal said first-year students complained that seniors ordered them to bring cigarettes, food items, and pick up deliveries. Students also al-

leged they faced physical punishments, including wall-chairs and sit-ups, and were occasionally forced to miss regular academic activities and clinical postings.

Meanwhile, the Sultan Bazar police have registered the case, counselled those involved, and are investigating whether more students were actively involved.

Bandi Sanjay urges cooperatives to set up solar plants across TG

UNION Minister of State for Home Affairs Bandi Sanjay Kumar called upon cooperative societies across Telangana to take advantage of the Central Government's support and establish solar power plants to generate substantial revenue.

During his visit to Choppadandi in Karimnagar district, he said that a 1 MW solar plant can earn up to Rs 50 lakh per year, making it a highly profitable venture for cooperatives and individuals with adequate land.

The Minister inspected a Jan Aushadhi Kendra during his tour and interacted with staff and beneficiaries. He noted that the centres were providing quality medicines at significantly lower prices and urged people to make full use of them. Later, he visited the newly established

1 MW solar plant on the outskirts of Choppadandi and reviewed details related to project cost, loan structure, and operational capacity. In a media statement, Bandi Sanjay explained that under the PM-KUSUM scheme, the Modi government is actively encouraging cooperatives to set up solar plants.

He said NABARD is offering loans covering over 80% of the project cost, making it easier for socie-

nancial systems," he said. The Minister highlighted that the Choppadandi plant is the first such project in the Karimnagar Parliamentary constituency, while four others have been set up in Peddapalli district. He urged cooperatives across the state to adopt this model, noting that DISCOMs purchase power at Rs 3 per unit, ensuring steady revenue.

Bandi Sanjay also clarified that individuals can apply for solar plant loans at 9% interest, with a 3% rebate for timely repayment. He said that setting up a 1 MW plant requires 3 acres of land, and those with available land should apply immediately to benefit from the scheme.

Reiterating the Centre's commitment, he said the government would extend all necessary support to expand solar infrastructure and help rural communities achieve financial stability.

ties to invest. The total cost of a 1 MW plant is Rs 3.80 crore, of which the cooperative must contribute Rs 40 lakh, while Rs 3.40 crore is provided as a loan by NABARD at 4% interest.

He added that cooperatives that repay EMIs on time receive a 3% interest rebate, effectively reducing the loan interest to just 1%. "This is a golden opportunity for cooperatives to secure long-term income and strengthen rural fi-
