KAVITHA FIRES RS 1.4K-CR FUND SALVO AGAINST BRS

BRS under fire as Kavitha raises Rs 1,400-cr fund allegation. Calls for distribution of alleged party funds to families of Telangana martyrs

TELANGANA Rakshana Sena president Kalvakuntla Kavitha on Thursday demanded that the alleged Rs 1,400 crore corruption funds of the BRS be allocated to the families of martyrs (Amaraveerulu).

The TRS leader said that she would never return to the BRS.

She made these comments during her visit to Kothagudem on Thursday. Addressing a massive gathering, Kavitha made it clear that despite systematic, state-sponsored intimi-

ation, her fight for the people, the martyrs, and the working class of Telangana remains unstoppable.

Striking at the very core of the BRS leadership, Kavitha demanded that the Rs 1,400 crore currently sitting in the BRS party account, which she labelled as illicit proceeds accumulated through systemic corporate quid pro quo; be immediately confiscated and distributed to the families of Telangana martyrs at Rs 1 crore each. She levelled grave corruption allegations against KTR and Harish Rao, exposing how public assets were systematically traded for cor-

porate favours.

Kavitha exposed how KTR abused his ministerial powers to orchestrate a massive quid pro deal with his close associate, Pradeep Constructions, granting illegal building permissions for mega-structures.

She further alleged that Rs 188 crore of these ill-gotten funds were recently used by KTR to acquire The Pioneer English newspaper in a desperate bid to buy out the mainstream media narrative and suppress TRS's grassroots anti-corruption exposés.

Kavitha branded Harish Rao as "anaconda of cor-



ruption" behind the Kaleshwaram and Palamuru Lift Irrigation projects. She lambasted the BRS for continuing to project a leader whose tenure left permanent stains of corruption on the state.

Arvind demands CBI probe into Kavitha's charges on KCR family

The delay in handing over the case to the Central agency will give impression that Cong and BRS in cahoots

BJP MP Arvind Dharmpuri has demanded that Chief Minister Revanth Reddy immediately order a CBI investigation into the corruption and quid pro quo allegations made by Kavitha against the KCR family and Harish Rao. The Nizamabad MP said that the allegations made by Kalvakuntla Kavita on BRS party funds, quid pro quo transactions, alleged agreements with Pradeep Constructions,

political support to Phoenix, and land allocations to Andhra contractors by the previous and current governments are very serious. He urged Chief Minister Revanth Reddy to order a CBI investigation without any doubt on these allegations. Arvind stated that the delay in handing over the investigation into the corruption in the Kaleshwaram project to the CBI, protecting KTR from investigating despite evidence of corruption in the e-car race, and the failure to take

action against those responsible for the phone tapping scam so far have already made people doubt the sincerity of Chief Minister Revanth Reddy, and that people believe that the two parties, Congress and BRS, are in cahoots.

Therefore, he said, to maintain the trust of the people, the government should immediately hand over this matter to the CBI, bring the truth to light with complete transparency and take strict action against the accused.

HC grants bail to Bandi's son in POCSO case

Bageerath was arrested on May 16 and was subsequently remanded to judicial custody

THE Telangana High Court on Thursday granted conditional bail to Union Minister Bandi Sanjay Kumar's son, Bageerath, who was arrested in connection with a POCSO case registered against him.

The High Court on July 6 reserved its orders in the bail petition filed by Bageerath. The court allowed Bageerath's plea on furnishing two sureties of Rs One lakh each and other conditions, including directing him to cooperate with the investigation.

Earlier, Public Prosecutor Palle Nageshwara Rao had opposed the granting of bail to the accused and argued that he may influence the witnesses and tamper with evidence, if released on bail. The police are going to file a chargesheet, he further submitted. The petitioner's counsel argued that Bageerath had been in judicial custody for more than 40 days and sought for granting bail. Bageerath was arrested on the night of May 16 in the POCSO case and was subsequently remanded to judicial custody. The case was registered on May 8 under relevant sections of the BNS and the POCSO Act at Pet-basheerabad police station, based on a complaint lodged by the mother of a
