Medigadda row: Eatala pushes for water lifting, slams political delays

BJP LEADER WARNS OF CRISIS IF IRRIGATION CONCERNS ARE IGNORED

MALKAJGIRI MP Eatala Rajender on Friday demanded that the State government lift Godavari water without storing it at Medigadda and urged Irrigation Minister Uttam Kumar Reddy to set aside political differences and take constructive steps to address water-related issues.

Addressing the media, Rajender said, "I am a son of Telangana soil and an activist; that is my identity. I will not remain silent when the people of Telangana suffer due to political issues. I will question those responsible."

Rejecting allegations that he was speaking at someone's behest, the BJP leader said, "I do not speak because someone prompts me, gives me a script or to please anyone. I have no need to respond to those making such baseless allegations."

Rajender said he was not interested in criticising the Congress or any other political party but would question those responsible for protecting the interests of Telangana.

He said there was no balancing reservoir for the Devadula Lift Irrigation Scheme, yet water was

being pumped without one. "I am not asking for water to be stored at Medigadda. I am asking the government to lift the water that is flowing downstream," he said.

Warning the government against delaying irrigation measures for political reasons, Rajender said any decision affecting farmers would have serious consequences.

The MP claimed that Hyderabad was already facing a water supply deficit of 107 MGD and questioned how the city would cope if a severe water crisis emerged. He

warned that such a situation could put people in Hyderabad, North Telangana, Khammam and Nalgonda in difficulty.

Taking a dig at Chief Minister A Revanth Reddy, Rajender said the government would understand the public mood if a water crisis occurred.

"Even KCR was sent home by the people, and the Chief Minister will meet the same fate if the government ignores public concerns," he cautioned.

He urged the State government

to consult irrigation experts and engineers and focus on solutions instead of engaging in political blame games.

Rajender clarified that the BJP had no objection to the recommendations of the National Dam Safety Authority (NDSA) and appealed to the government not to make baseless allegations.

"For the BJP, it is Nation first, Party next and Individual last. Since I am a son of Telangana soil, for me, it is Telangana first, Party next and Individual last," he said.

Chamala slams KTR's 'CM dream', says TG backing Cong

HYDERABAD: Bhongir MP Chamala Kiran Kumar Reddy on Friday launched a scathing attack on BRS working president KT Rama Rao (KTR), alleging that the former ruling party was "day-dreaming" about returning to power despite losing public confidence.

Addressing the media at Gandhi Bhavan, Chamala said KTR was behaving as if elections had already been announced and the BRS had already secured victory. He claimed that the Congress was receiving positive feedback in surveys related to the Jubilee Hills by-election and recalled KTR's earlier prediction of a 50,000-vote victory margin for the BRS. However, Chamala said the BRS suffered defeats in the Lok Sabha elections and lost its sitting seats in Jubilee Hills and Cantonment. He asserted that people of Telangana had rejected the BRS and were supporting the Congress government's 'Praja Palana' initiative. Targeting former Chief Minister K

Chandrashekar Rao, Chamala alleged that KCR failed to fulfil his promise of appointing a Dalit as Chief Minister after Telangana's formation. Taking a dig at KTR's press conferences, he said the BRS leader was acting like "Pulikeshi" while trying to protect the party cadre and dreaming of becoming Chief Minister.

Questioning former minister Harish Rao's remarks on irrigation, Chamala asked whether he could clear pending irrigation project dues if given the Irrigation portfolio for three months. He alleged that the Medigadda barrage had become a "graveyard" under the previous government.

₹3.5-cr film offer fails to take off, director booked

THE Cyberabad Economic Offences Wing (EOW) has registered a cheating case against Telugu film director G Ashok Babu over allegations that he collected Rs 3.5 crore from a family after promising to launch their son as a hero in the Telugu film industry.

According to the complaint filed by Hanumantha Rao, the director allegedly received the amount in multiple instalments from him and his family after assuring them that their son would be introduced as the

lead actor in a Telugu film. The complainant alleged that the payments, totalling Rs 3.5 crore, were made at different stages based on the director's assurances.

The family alleged that despite receiving the money, the promised film project never materialised. They further claimed that repeated requests for the return of the amount went unanswered, leaving them with no option but to approach the police.

Based on the complaint, the Cyberabad EOW registered a case under relevant sections and initiated an investigation into the al-

legations. Police officials have summoned the director for questioning and are examining the financial transactions between the parties, along with the circumstances under which the money was allegedly collected.

Police also verifying the documentary evidence including financial records and other material submitted by the complainant to establish the sequence of events.

Police said the investigation is in progress, and further action will be taken based on the findings of the probe.
