

BRS demands apology from CM over criminal waste jibe

BHARAT Rashtira Samithi leaders KT Rama Rao and Harish Rao demanded an unconditional apology from Chief Minister A Revanth Reddy on July 30 for referring to engineering graduates as criminal waste. Taking to social media platform X, KT Rama Rao strongly questioned the Chief Minister's qualifications to comment on the capabilities

of young engineers, asking whether he had ever written a competitive examination, attended a job interview, or worked in a professional environment during his lifetime. He further termed him a former real estate broker turned blackmailer who hustled his way into buying the Chief Minister post in



a bankrupt Congress party. Meanwhile, Harish Rao sharply criticised Revanth Reddy for his disparaging comments, describing the remark as deeply insulting to both students and the teaching fraternity. He emphasised that engineering graduates from Telangana are excelling across

the globe, bringing immense pride and international recognition to the state, adding that insulting them ultimately disrespects every educator who trained them. Demanding that Revanth Reddy immediately withdraw his statement and tender an apology, Harish Rao also accused him of failing as Education Minister, pointing out that government schools across Telangana currently lack basic infrastructural resources.

Twin reservoirs receive fresh inflows amid rains across Hyd

HYDERABAD: MODERATE rainfall across catchment areas over the past two days has triggered fresh flood inflows into Hyderabad's twin reservoirs, Himayatsagar and Osmansagar,

providing a welcome boost to the city's water resources. According to the Hyderabad Water Board, Himayatsagar is currently receiving an inflow of 400 cusecs. The reservoir's water level has risen to 1,760.80 feet, holding 2.138 TMC of water against its full



reservoir level (FRL) of 1,763.50 feet and total storage capacity of 2.521 TMC.

Similarly, Osmansagar is recording an inflow of 150 cusecs, with its water level standing at 1,783.35 feet and storage reaching 1.241 TMC, against an FRL of 1,790.00 feet and total capacity of 3.518 TMC. Despite the fresh inflows, the Water Board has not opened the gates of either reservoir, as water levels remain below FRL limits. Officials confirmed the situation is under constant watch, with storage levels being monitored round the clock. The fresh inflows serve as a positive development for Hyderabad's drinking water security, as ongoing monsoon showers continue to replenish key water sources supplying the capital.

TG BJP chief terms Rahul's reaction as selective outrage

TELANGANA BJP Chief N Ramachandra Rao termed Congress MP and Leader of Opposition in Lok Sabha Rahul Gandhi's raising hue and cry over police action in Delhi following the Cock-croch Janata Party (CJP) parliament march violence as selective outrage. Taking to social media platform X on Thursday, he reminded how the Congress-led state government under Chief Minister Revanth Reddy had deployed police to suppress protesting job-seeking students in Hyderabad. He noted that when the state's youth took to the streets after being betrayed over the promise of two lakh jobs



annually, police force was unleashed upon them, yet there was complete radio silence from the Congress leadership.

Rao stated that if there were genuine concern for students, Rahul Gandhi would have pulled up his protégé, Telangana Chief Minister Revanth Reddy, for jeopardising the future of 20

lakh SC, ST, BC, and EBC students by failing to clear pending fee reimbursement dues. He remarked that this silence exposes how selective outrage remains his favourite flavour. Furthermore, he highlighted that neither Rahul Gandhi nor anyone in his family has apologised to the people of Telangana for firing on stu-

dents during the 1969 Telangana agitation.

Besides, during the second phase of the Telangana agitation, nearly 1,200 youth and students laid down their lives because of the Congress Party's repeated U-turns and betrayals, for which no apology has been tendered.

Apart from this, he alleged that the Congress government in Telangana even tried to grab university lands for real estate development. Pointing directly at Rahul Gandhi, N Ramachandra Rao stated that it was never really about welfare or student rights, asserting that the Congress leader is merely using students as political pawns for selfish gains.

Resurvey will ensure error-free land records, asserts Rev Secy

REVENUE Secretary DS Lokesh Kumar has stated that every mistake in land records will be corrected through the ongoing land re-survey, expressing confidence that the exercise will be completed within the stipulated deadline. Speaking to The Hans India, DS Lokesh Kumar said that encroachments on private properties will be detected and boundaries will be accurately fixed by determining precise latitudes and longitudes. He noted that land records will be cleaned up simultaneously with the re-survey, which will ultimately help create clear, accurate documentation across the state.

He explained that Telangana has a total geographical area of 1,12,077 square kilometres, amounting to approximately 112.08 lakh hectares or 276.95 lakh acres. Of this total, 25 lakh acres comprise assigned lands, 66 lakh acres are forest lands,

and about 13 to 14 lakh acres are occupied by irrigation projects, roads, schools, colleges, and other government establishments. However, approximately 65,000 acres of land remain under dispute, and DS Lokesh Kumar emphasized that the re-survey will provide a clear, unambiguous picture regarding these properties.

He informed that the re-survey is already underway across the state, having been successfully completed in 35 villages, while pilot surveys have commenced in selected villages across almost all mandals. DS Lokesh Kumar affirmed that the re-survey will be completed within the timeframe mandated by the government. It may be recalled that Revenue Minister Ponguleti Srinivas Reddy had set a target deadline of March 2027 to finish the comprehensive statewide land re-survey exercise across three distinct phases. The Minister also previously stated that farmers will be allotted unique 'Bhudhaar' identification numbers for every land parcel.

Police step up probe against suspended JH stn inspector

POLICE have intensified their investigation into the case involving suspended Jubilee Hills Inspector Srinivas Reddy on July 30. The victim submitted a fresh complaint to senior police officials, alleging that she is being personally targeted through false information spread against her, and requested prompt action against those involved. As part of the ongoing probe, the

Jubilee Hills DCP questioned the suspended inspector.

According to reports, the victim alleged that certain police officers are supporting Srinivas Reddy by carrying out a negative campaign against her. She informed senior officials that Srinivas Reddy maintains close ties with a prominent builder based on Road No 5 in Jubilee Hills, who has been assisted in his following his suspension.

The victim further al-

leged that she paid lakhs of Rs to Srinivas Reddy due to persistent threats from him, submitting relevant supporting evidence to substantiate her claims. Breaking down in tears before senior officers, she requested immediate criminal action against the suspended inspector. Senior officials assured a thorough inquiry into the allegations while examining the evidence submitted by the victim regarding extortion, threats, and malicious campaigning.

No gappe vappe...! Task Force teams target street food units

IN a major crackdown on unsafe street food manufacturing, the Hyderabad Food and Administrative Safety Task Force (H-FAST), along with Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation Food Safety officials, busted several unhygienic manufacturing units and destroyed 25 kg of ready-to-eat street food. Officials seized 10 kg of prepared samosas and 15 kg of prepared golgappe after finding them unfit for consumption. Inspections were conducted at a puri manufacturing unit and three samosa units

located in NM Guda, Attapur. During operations, officers found the facilities operating without valid food licenses under poor hygienic conditions, using substandard raw materials, and violating multiple food safety regulations. To safeguard public health, the prepared food was discarded on the spot, and legal proceedings were initiated against operators under the Food Safety and Standards Act 2006.

In a separate drive, officers inspected Urvi Food Products, a soya chunks manufacturing unit in Jalpally, uncovering severe hygiene violations.

The inspection revealed

workers handling food with bare hands and feet, poor sanitation, fly infestations, an absence of mandatory food safety records, and improper storage of raw materials alongside finished goods. The food safety officer immediately ordered the destruction of unhygienically manufactured soya chunks, and legal action was initiated under the Food Safety and Standards Act 2006. H-FAST stated that enforcement drives will continue across Hyderabad to curb unsafe manufacturing practices and ensure food sold to the public meets prescribed safety standards.



Police arrest 3 in murder bid case

HYDERABAD: Sleuths of Tappachabutra police apprehended three persons in connection with an attempted murder case stemming from a family property dispute at Daibagh in Hyderabad on Thursday. According to police, the prime accused Mohammed Dastagir Shareef allegedly conspired to kill his sister-in-law Shameem Sulthana over property disagreements and domestic issues. The main accused sought assistance from two accomplices, Ghulam Nabi Qureshi and Mohd Osman, to execute the murder plan. On 27 July, the trio reached the victim's residence on a scooter and gained entry. Ghulam Nabi Qureshi attacked the woman with a butcher knife, assaulted her husband when he attempted to intervene, and chased the victim before stabbing her in the stomach. The assailants fled the scene after local residents gathered at the spot. Police recovered the scooter, weapon used in the offence, and other key evidence.
