

Cong leaders from Parakal slam Konda Sushmita’s remarks

• She is causing political damage to Minister Konda Surekha. The person who is not a member of the Congress party, should know her political status and speak, they assert

CONGRESS leaders from Parakala constituency strongly condemned the comments made by Konda Sushmita Patel, daughter of Minister Konda Surekha, on Chief Minister Revanth Reddy and MLA Revuri Prakash Reddy.

Addressing a press conference held at the MLA's camp office in Parakala town of Hanumakonda district on Thursday, former TPCC general secretary and former MPP Bhimagani Soujanya said that it is meaningless for Sushmita to criticise CM Revanth Reddy for asking people to bless Revuri Prakash Reddy again after seeing the development of Parakala in a recent public meeting held in the constituency.

She said that it is prerogative of the Congress party high command to give a ticket to whom he deems fit. Moreover, it is not right for those who are not related



to the Congress to interfere in the internal affairs of the party. She said that Sushmita does not have a Congress party membership and should first know her political status before speaking.

She said that it is Sushmita who is causing political damage to Minister Konda Surekha by commenting that the family that moved away from Parakala out of fear of former MLA Challa Dharmareddy is theirs and by interfering in irrelevant matters. She made it clear that if the Congress party gives a ticket to Revuri Prakash Reddy, all the party ranks will work for his victory.

Sushmita, who says that Parakala is hers, demanded that she must tell the people what development she has done for Parakala. She demanded an immediate public apology for her comments

on CM Revanth Reddy and MLA Revuri Prakash Reddy. Former ZPTC and DCC general secretary Padi Kalpana Devi said, "Parakala Gadda is not anyone's property." She said that it is strange for someone from a family that has been away from Parakala since 2012 to claim that Parakala Gadda is theirs. She suggested that if they want to grow politically, they should first change their language and personality. She warned that if CM Revanth Reddy and MLA Prakash Reddy are criticized, the Congress ranks will not stand moot spectator.

Former Nagaram Sarpanch and DCC secretary Katkuri Sravanthi said, "It is not right to make inappropriate comments on CM Revanth Reddy and MLA Revuri Prakash Reddy, who

prioritises women. She said that Sushmita's comments in the past were forgiven because of her mother and Minister Konda Surekha. She said it was inappropriate to criticize Congress leaders once again.

She stated that Sushmita Patel does not have any membership in the Congress party.

Dr Kadiyam Kavya demands special railway division at Kazipet

WARANGAL MP Dr Kadiyam Kavya has demanded that Kazipet be made the centre of a special railway division, citing its strategic importance as a major passenger and freight hub in Telangana. At a review meeting of MPs chaired by the South Central Railway General Manager at Rail Nilayam in Secunderabad on Thursday, she raised 19 proposals concerning rail-

way development in the Warangal-Kazipet region. Kavya sought speedy completion of the Kazipet Railway Manufacturing Unit and creation of local employment and skill-training opportunities. She demanded two additional platforms, foot overbridges and escalators at Kazipet Junction, besides modernisation of Kazipet Town station and more originating express trains.

She also sought daily operation of the Padmavati Express, expansion of the railway hospital, improved facilities in railway colonies, and additional infrastructure at loco sheds. Other demands included a new railway station to improve connectivity to Bhupalpally, a second ROB at Fatima Bridge, and shifting of the Vijayawada crew depot to Kazipet or Warangal.

Kavya said she would continue efforts to develop Kazipet as a major railway junction in South India.

PROF. Aldas Janaiah, Vice-Chancellor of Acharya Jayashankar Telangana Agricultural University, along with Telangana University Vice-Chancellor Yadagiri Rao, performed the Bhoomi Pooja for the new Agricultural College buildings at Dichpally on Wednesday.

Speaking on the occasion, Prof. Janaiah said the Rs

123-crore project would include four additional blocks and modern facilities for students. The college, the 11th agricultural college in Telangana, currently has an intake of 120 students.

BJP threatens intensified stir over pending student fee dues

BJP Telangana president N Ramchander Rao warned that the party would intensify its agitation if the State government failed to clear pending fee reimbursement and scholarship dues. Addressing a 'Fee Bakayi-BJP Ladayi' Maha Dharna organised by the BJYM in Karimnagar, Rao alleged that nearly 20 lakh students were awaiting

payments, putting financial pressure on students, parents and educational insti-

tutions. He claimed around Rs 8,000 crore in dues were pending and alleged that

the government had failed to release even the Rs 2,000 crore it had proposed following High Court concerns. He said delayed payments were affecting colleges and faculty salaries.

BJYM State president Ganesh Kunde said protests would be intensified and warned of possible Collectorate sieges if the demands were not met. BJP leaders and students participated in the dharna.

TRANSPORT and BC Welfare Minister Ponnam Prabhakar on Thursday announced that Keshavpur village in Elkathurthi mandal will be developed as

a Solar Model Village, with solar power facilities and solar pumps to be promoted across the village.

Participating in the "Ponnam Anna for Villages - Public Governance in Villages" programme, the Minister received petitions from villagers and farmers and directed officials to resolve problems on

the spot. He said solar systems would be installed in households, enabling residents to meet their electricity needs and sell surplus power. Road works from Gunturpalle to Keshavpur have been sanctioned at a cost of Rs 3.5 crore.

Prabhakar also urged villagers to adopt water conservation measures under the Jala Siri programme and encouraged farmers to take up oil palm cultivation. He assured Rs 10 lakh for village development if oil palm is cultivated on 300 acres. He said a sub-market yard would be established and Keshavpur developed as a key village in the Husnabad constituency. The Minister also reviewed welfare schemes, housing, sanitation, healthcare and pension programmes.

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
