Dhoolpet's Ganesh craft hub faces a readymade challenge

Artisans say shrinking orders and high production costs are forcing a shift

PREPARATIONS are in full swing ahead of the 11-day Ganesh Chaturthi festivities, which is starting from September 14. As preparations for the festival gather momentum across Hyderabad, the city's idol markets are witnessing a major shift towards readymade Ganesh idols, with a significant number being brought in from Maharashtra and other nearby districts.

Even Dhoolpet, which is traditionally regarded as Hyderabad's hub of idol makers and skilled artisans, is now increasingly selling readymade idols instead of manufacturing them locally.

Unlike in the past, ar-



tisans, who used to spend several days crafting the idols for the Ganesh Festival, are now procuring the readymade idols from other states to earn more money effortlessly.

Ganesh idols from other states have sprouted up in every nook and corner of the city, as these local artisans, who have been crafting the idols for many decades are now selling idols

transported from Sholapur, Pune, Nashik, Malegaon and several smaller towns and villages in Maharashtra.

According to the idol-making community, nearly

90 per cent of the Ganesh idols currently available in the market are being transported from Maharashtra. Telangana Idol Makers Welfare Association Vice president Kailash Singh Hazari, an artisan, said that orders for making idols from locals have gone down from the last few years.

"Earlier, we artisans used to craft idols and sell them during the festival. But now, if an artisan makes an idol without receiving an order from people in the city, we face huge losses," said Kailash Singh. He added, "We are facing huge losses after spending lakhs of rupees on making the idols."

In Dhoolpet, only a handful of people are now making Ganesh idols based on specific customer orders. Most of the idols are

being brought from outside and sold here," said Ram Murthy, another artisan. Dhoolpet has around 70 to 80 idol makers and artisans, but only a limited number continue to manufacture idols from scratch. The rest have shifted towards sourcing finished idols from outside locations and selling them in Hyderabad.

Kailash Singh said, "People generally have the perception that idols manufactured in Maharashtra are better. However, idols made in Hyderabad, particularly Dhoolpet, have better finishing and quality. Another major advantage of buying locally manufactured idols is that the artisans are available to provide support if there is any damage during transportation or installation," he said.

Clear the wires, avert mishaps: Sajjanar

Police Commissioner directs departments to ensure safe Ganesh procession routes and electrical connections

HYDERABAD Police Commissioner VC Sajjanar on Wednesday directed all government departments to work in close coordination and execute proactive preventive measures for the smooth conduct of the Ganesh festival.

Addressing an inter-departmental coordination meeting held at Visvesvaraya Bhavan in Khairatabad, Sajjanar instructed officials to immediately clear loose and hanging electricity, cable, and internet wires obstructing procession routes,

maintaining sufficient height clearance to avoid mishaps like the Ramanathapur incident.

He stressed that pandal organizers must receive safe electrical connections adhering strictly to regulations, complete mandatory earthing, and secure necessary approvals from the Electrical Inspectorate. Additionally, electricity department officials were instructed to maintain continuous communication with law enforcement and inform local police before carrying out power shutdowns or wire clearance operations across procession routes.

MMC to set up baby ponds for Ganesh idol immersion

TO ensure a safe, smooth, and eco-friendly Ganesh idol immersion procession, Malkajgiri Municipal Corporation Commissioner T Vinay Krishna Reddy, alongside Uppal Zonal Commissioner Radhika Gupta, conducted a field inspection on Wednesday, directing officials to establish a baby pond near existing water bodies for idol immersions. Inspecting Rampalli Lake in Nagararam Ward under Ghatkesar Circle, the Commissioner instructed that the artificial pond be designed for future Bathukamma festivities.

He directed officials to create two separate immer-

sion zones for small and large idols to ensure order and safety. Key logistics ordered include deploying cranes, setting up medical aid desks, stationing ambulances, ensuring fire safety, establishing a control room, and removing old and newly immersed idols promptly.

The Commissioner instructed that flowers and organic puja materials be collected separately for composting into natural fertilizer, while general waste undergoes scientific processing. Emphasizing continuous field monitoring, he urged inter-departmental coordination to ensure smooth operations across the municipality throughout the festival.

THE Telangana Information Commission (TGIC) will organise a two-day National Conference on 'Operational Uniformity in Implementation of RTI: Challenges and Solutions' at the Administrative Staff College of India (ASCI), Hyderabad, on September 10 and 11.

Sponsored by the National Federation of Information Commissioners in India (NFICI) and organised in collaboration with ASCI, the conference will bring together Chief Information Commissioners, In-

formation Commissioners, legal experts, policymakers and senior administrators from across the country. Around 20 State Chief Information Commissioners are likely to participate.

guest at the inaugural session and deliver the keynote address. The conference will focus on strengthening implementation of the Right to Information Act, 2005, with emphasis on uniform procedures, reducing pendency, timely

disposal of cases, effective hearing mechanisms, proactive disclosure under Section 4, digitalisation and capacity building of Public Information Officers and First Appellate Authorities. Discussions will also address preventing misuse of RTI without restricting legitimate citizen access and strengthening the independence and effectiveness of Information Commissioners.

Chief Minister A Revanth Reddy will attend a dinner interaction with the Central Chief Information Commissioner and State Chief Information Commissioners on September 10.

CBI arrests ex-DRM of Waltair Dvn for amassing ₹2.19 cr illegal assets

THE Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) officials arrested former Divisional Railway Manager (DRM), East Coast Railways, Waltair Division, Visakhapatnam, Saurabh Prasad, for allegedly amassing assets worth Rs 2.19 crore. The agency registered a disproportionate assets case against the accused officer.

In 2024, the CBI Delhi unit officials registered cases under corruption charges and conducted raids at the residence of the accused officer. The officials found cash in dollars, euros, Mauritius rupees and francs, besides gold coins, gold and silver jewellery

and various documents pertaining to income, assets and expenditure in the name of Saurabh Prasad and his family members.

In continuation of the probe, the CBI found that the accused officer had amassed Rs 2.19 crore in assets illegally. Saurabh Prasad joined the Indian Railways as an Assistant Mechanical Engineer in 1994. After being promoted and posted in various positions, from 2018 to September 2021, he was posted as CME with Konkan Railway. He was posted as CME (Planning) at Central Railway from September 2021 to July 2023 and was posted as DRM, Waltair Division of East Coast Railways, from

Details of the income, assets and expenditure of Saurabh Prasad between 2021 and 2024:

July 2023 to November 16, 2024.

The CBI officials stated that Saurabh Prasad, while in public service from 2021 to 2024, acquired assets worth Rs 2.19 crore that were disproportionate to all his known legal sources of income, for which he could not satisfactorily account.

It was further revealed that Saurabh Prasad retired as Director, DRDO, and his mother is a housewife and is not dependent on him. His wife, Manjushree Saurabh Prasad, was employed with Tata Steel till July 2023 and left the job afterwards. She had some income from house rent and consultancy jobs.
