

Focus on devotee safety, facilities during Kanipakam Brahmotsavams

COMPREHENSIVE arrangements being made for the annual Brahmotsavams of Sri Varasiddhi Vinayaka Swamy temple at Kanipakam, ensuring safety and convenience of devotees throughout the 21-day festival to be held from September 14 to October 4. District Collector Sumit Kumar reviewed the arrangements with officials at a meeting held on Wednesday

at Kanipakam temple.

He instructed all departments to implement the decisions taken at the meeting without delay and work in coordination. Reducing waiting time for darshan, ensuring crowd safety and provid-

ing basic facilities to devotees should be given priority. Additional CCTV cameras and fire safety equipment would be installed, while roads, drinking water, electricity and lighting facilities would also be strengthened. Offi-

cials have also been asked to focus on infrastructure and other requirements around the gopuram, temple premises and nearby panchayats.

Puthalapattu MLA K Murali Mohan said every effort should be made to ensure that devotees do not face inconvenience or security issues during the festival. Priority would be given to common devotees throughout the 21-day celebrations. Three ambulances will be kept ready to respond to medical emergencies. A fire safety vehicle equipped with modern technology and additional fire personnel will also be deployed to deal with fire-related and other emergencies. Transport arrangements will receive special attention, particularly at night. A daily

bus service from Kanipakam to the district headquarters at 11.30 pm has been proposed to help devotees who may otherwise face difficulty finding transport. The MLA also said silk robes would be presented to Lord Vinayaka on behalf of the State government on Vinayaka Chavithi. District Superintendent of Police Tushar Dudi said adequate police personnel would be deployed on major festival days. A command control room would be set up at the temple, with police personnel working round the clock to manage security and crowd movement. Temple Executive Officer K Penchala Kishore, chairman V Surendrababu alias Mani Naidu, board members, and others attended the meeting.

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Venkaiah Naidu calls for moral education in school

FORMER Vice-President M Venkaiah Naidu has urged governments to make moral education mandatory in schools, stressing the urgent need to instil cultural and ethical values in students from an early age.

Speaking in Venkatachalam during the silver jubilee celebrations of Swarna Bharat Trust (SBT), Naidu raised strong concerns over youth media consumption. He called for a ban on mobile phone use for students aged 16 to 18 years and advocated for legal restrictions to prevent them from maintaining social media accounts. Pointing out that social media is increasingly turning 'anti-social' and harming lives, he cited Australia's recent restrictions as a model for Indian Central and State governments to emulate through stringent legislation.

Reflecting on his public career, Venkaiah Naidu

highlighted his tenure as Union Minister for Rural Development under the Vajpayee government. He cited Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY), which brought all-weather roads to lakhs of villages, as one of his most satisfying achievements. With roughly 55% of India's population residing in rural areas, he emphasized that national progress is impossible without rural empowerment.

Venkaiah Naidu com-

mended the Swarna Bharat Trust, founded in 2001, for its 25 years of service through free medical camps, youth skill development, and women's empowerment. He added that he has always opposed dynastic politics, encouraging his children to serve society through philanthropy instead. Swarna Bharat Trust Managing Trustee Deepa Venkat, representatives of print and electronic media and Trust members attended the interaction.

Tirupati police launch night security drive to safeguard pilgrims

TO ensure the safety of over one lakh daily pilgrims, Tirupati district police have launched an intensive night-time security operation across the holy city and surrounding areas. District SP L Subba Rayudu personally led the drive on Tuesday night, conducting surprise inspections at critical locations to assess ground-level deployments, vehicle checks, and night patrols.

With high pilgrim footfall continuing long after sunset, special police teams now operate from 10 pm onwards, focusing on area domination, monitoring suspicious movements, and conducting random vehicle checks across Tirupati, Chandragiri, and key adjoining zones. Each zone is directly managed by a DSP reporting to the Additional SP, with real-time tracking coordinated through the district's central command

and control room to allow rapid deployment.

The security sweep targets sensitive installations, digital infrastructure sites, gathering spots, and late-night commercial venues operating past permitted hours. Police have also set up dedicated checkpoints to crack down on drunk driving, enforcing strict legal action against offenders who pose a threat to late-traveling devotees.

Key transit hubs and high-footfall locations—including the RTC Bus Stand, Railway Station area, Alipiri, TVS Showroom junction,

Group Theatre, and Leela Mahal—were thoroughly inspected under the ground execution of Additional SP Ravi Manoharachari, DSP Bhaktavatsalam, and Alipiri CI Ram Kishore.

Emphasising that devotee safety remains the department's top priority, SP Subba Rayudu stated that officers are working around the clock to maintain a secure environment. He warned that continuous surveillance is active throughout the city, and strict action will be taken against anyone threatening public safety or disrupting order.
